3 KINDS OF TOOLS

Three different levels of giving

LEVEL-1: THE REED OR MEASURING TAPES

The reed, or rod, measured distances and could be used as a straight edge. This is one of the more common hand tools in the Bible and the best tape measure that they had at the time!

"And behold a wall on the outside of the house round about, and in the man's hand a measuring reed of six cubits long by the cubit and an hand breadth: so he measured the breadth of the building, one reed; and the height, one reed. Ezekiel 40:5

LEVED 2: THE MALLET OR HAMMERS (NAILGUNS)

The hammer, or mallet, referred to a tool that was used for working stone, beating metals, wood-carving, and also driving nails and tent pins.

"So the carpenter encouraged the goldsmith, and he that smootheth with the hammer him that smote the anvil, saying, It is ready for the sodering: and he fastened it with nails, that it should not be moved." Isaiah 41:7



Almost all instances of the axe in the Bible had to do with either cutting down trees or shaping wood. In one verse, it mentions that the axe is made of iron.

"And Abimelech gat him up to mount Zalmon, he and all the people that were with him; and Abimelech took an axe in his hand, and cut down a bough from the trees, and took it, and laid it on his shoulder, and said unto the people that were with him, What ye have seen me do, make haste, and do as I have done." Judges 9:48
